## **HOW ABOUT WITHIN THE NEXT WEEK AFTER YOUR RELEASE?**

**We are developing an action health plan to address the health and social issues for women after their release from prison. You will be asked some questions about your health, education, job skills, family, support, housing and the nine health goals that women in prison have told us are important to them.**

**Community-based researchers will invite you to participate and consent within 7 days after your release and at 3, 6, 9, and 12 months. You will receive an honorarium of \$20 (in giftcards) for each interview, which will take about an hour. To book an appointment for any or for all of these interviews, contact us at any time within a year of your release from prison.**
